ReDiscover's Adult Suicide Prevention Program works to reduce suicide deaths and attempts among adults ages 18 and older through prevention, early intervention, and timely support. The program places a strong focus on individuals at higher risk for suicide, including adults with suicidal ideation and/or previously attempted suicide.

**Through ReDiscover's Adult Suicide Prevention Program, we hope to prevent suicide among adults by identifying risk early, increasing access to care, and providing coordinated support for those most vulnerable.**

### Eligibility

#### ReDiscover's Adult Suicide Prevention Program serves adults:

- Ages 18 or older who reside in Jackson or Cass county
- With chronic suicidal thoughts or behaviors
- Who require intensive interventions to assist with stability and safety

### How it Works

#### Referral

At the request of a hospital, college, or in response to a crisis call, the Show Me Zero Suicide team is contacted.

#### Action

With permission from the client, the Suicide Prevention Case Manager will immediately stabilize the client and then perform an assessment.

#### Care

The client will be provided with short term intensive case management and an ongoing bridge to long term treatment.
